## Summary of key findings for parents

### The provision meets requirements

- The provider and staff understand how to safeguard children and know what to do if they are concerned, to protect a child's welfare. The provider knows the procedures to follow to ensure that the staff she employs are suitable.
- Staff understand how to provide activities and experiences that build on children's learning at school. They know how to share information with parents and how to provide additional support to children who need it.
- Staff know how to help children stay healthy; for example, how to encourage children to make healthy food choices. They know how to encourage considerate behaviour in children and how to build children's confidence and self-esteem.
- The provider knows how to help staff develop their skills; for example, through attending regular training and having opportunities to discuss their performance. She understands the importance of evaluating the provision and planning further improvements.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The report states whether the provider continues to meet the requirements of registration.

## Inspection activities

- The inspector discussed with the manager how she plans to meet the requirements of the early years foundation stage.
- The inspector spoke with staff about their understanding of safeguarding, child protection, and first aid.
- The inspector sampled documentation, including staff qualifications and the provider's policies.
- The inspector reviewed the premises and discussed procedures for keeping children safe.
